

“You are a prostitute (male or female)”

You share body fluids with other persons in exchange for money (assume anyone who asks has the money to pay for your “time”).

“You are gay”

You exchange body fluids with other persons of the same sex (male).

Note: female to female transmission has been only rarely documented.

“You practice abstinence”

You choose not to exchange body fluids with any other person.

“You are bisexual”

You exchange body fluids with other persons, both male and female.

“You are an alcohol abuser”

You are more likely to share body fluids with other persons because alcohol reduces inhibitions.

“You are an intravenous drug user”

You exchange body fluids with other persons when you share contaminated needles. Because the drugs reduce your inhibitions you are more likely to share body fluids with anyone.

“You are promiscuous”

You exchange body fluids freely with as many other persons of the opposite sex as you can.

“You are a steroid abusing athlete”

You share body fluids with other persons when you use contaminated needles.

“You are monogamous”

You exchange body fluids only with your spouse. (Your spouse is a person of the opposite sex that you choose to marry — the first and only person with whom you exchange body fluids with.) You need to exchange body fluids with your spouse at least once more before the end of the activity.
